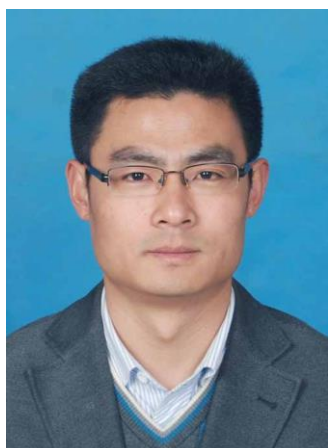

Wang Yitao & Liu Jian, Analysis on the Deviation of Behavioral Structure from Regulative Structure of the Board of Trustees of the Private HELs in China, Dec, 2014 [in Chinese now]

Abstract: The Law of Promoting the Development of Private Education states that board of trustees is the governing body oversees activities in a private higher education institution (HEI). Through text analysis, interview and survey, this study depicted and examined the responsibilities, member composition, decision making process of the boards and the relationship between the boards and the presidents. It revealed, although almost all private HEIs claim that they implement a "president responsibility system under the board", majority of boards in fact are founders' tool to control the institution. Using resource dependence theory, this study analyzed the reasons of the deviation of behavioral structure from regulative structure: due to being classified as a non-profit organization by the law, founders whose purpose of founding private HEIs as an investment for return have to strengthen their control to realize their goal, within

the context of single revenue resource (tuition as the result of the founders' capital and human capital investment) in Chinese private HEIs. Ambiguity in these laws has also opened a regulative vacuum for such a deviation.
